Currently, an increasing numbroof books and other forms of communication are being produced by people who have tenuously arrived at the interface of East and West. The book is not the presentation of a system of knowledge but is rather a way of knowing that will assist the reader in evaluating his or her knowledge, deriving new knowledge from experience, handling the explosion of information in our media-dominated environment, and generally staying flexible as life unfolds and evolves.
